4 Steps to Great Nature Study


Follow these steps to observe a nature object more thoroughly.



Notice

Notice what you can about whatever object you're looking at in nature. Tell what you notice out loud so that you remember.









Who, What, Where, When, Why, and How. For example: Who built this nest? What is it made of? Why was it built?

Reflect



Write, draw, or simply state out loud what you learned about this nature object.

What does that object remind you of? What does it look like to you?
